



Analyzing Your Socrative Class Report

You will need to download the class report in an Excel spreadsheet. You can retrieve any report you need by going to your room and clicking the *Manage Quizzes* button. That will open up the screen below. Then click on *Reports*.



Select the report you want by clicking on the quiz. Use the date-time stamp to ensure you are downloading the right one.



Analyzing Your Socrative Class Report

This is what the class report looks like as an Excel spreadsheet. The class scoring at the bottom of the report cannot interpret the responses that are written answers. We have created another spreadsheet which will convert written answers for columns E-H to numbers for analysis.

The numbers on the far right hand side represent the values assigned to each category: Strongly Agree = 5, Agree = 4, Neither Agree nor Disagree = 3, Disagree = 2, Strongly Disagree = 1

The numbers on the bottom two rows are the number of students who answered the prompt followed by the average for each prompt. You can copy the open ended responses into a Word document for further analysis as well.
